

I Y C Awards Criteria and Eligibility

GWA Volunteer of the Year Award

The GWA Volunteer of the Year Award recognizes outstanding achievement that is above and beyond the normal commitment of a chair or volunteers. The award will be presented to one active member in good standing who has made a significant contribution to GWA and/or the industry over the past year.

GWA Associate Member of the Year Award

The GWA Associate Member of the Year Award recognizes outstanding achievement that is above and beyond the normal commitment of a chair or volunteers. The award will be presented to one active Associate Member in good standing who has made a significant contribution to GWA and/or the industry over the past year.

GWA Local Member Network of the Year Award

The GWA Local Member Network of the Year Award recognizes a Local Member Network (LMN) that made a significant contribution to GWA and/or the industry over the past year through local advocacy. This LMN should represent a group that has made a difference in their local community by promoting awareness of the industry and the local market. The LMN recognized with this award must be an LMN in good standing with GWA that is in compliance with GWA's bylaws.

GWA Leadership Award (New 2009)

The GWA Leadership Award recognizes outstanding leadership within GWA and/or the industry over the past year, beyond the normal commitment of a chair, board member or volunteers. The award will be presented to one active member in good standing who has made a significant contribution to GWA and/or the industry over the past year.

GWA Outstanding Board Achievement Award

The GWA Outstanding Board Achievement Award recognizes outstanding individual achievement on the board over the past year. This award is not an annual award and can be awarded only at the President's discretion. The award recognizes a board member who has gone above and beyond when it comes to service to GWA and the board of directors. The award acknowledges individuals that develop innovative activities and programs or take on special projects beyond the scope of their position on the board of directors.

GWA Lifetime Achievement Award (New 2009)

The GWA Lifetime Achievement Award recognizes individual achievement by one member who exhibits qualities that advance and promote the Office Business Center

Industry and the association (GWA). Activity at the local member network and/or Association (GWA) level that benefit the industry and the association will be considered. Through this individual's actions, they keep the OBC industry vibrant and resilient. This award does not cover a specific time period and you may use examples from the candidate's entire career. GWA's Lifetime Achievement Award recognizes significant contributions within the OBC industry that raise the quality of products, services, and industry image. The award acknowledges individuals that develop innovative activities and programs that demonstrate sustainable and measurable results with regards to the OBC industry.
